recommend that pursuant to the Pincock-Vining Act and General Act and all other powers thereto enabling no person may enter lands, prospect or mine upon the following areas in the Cariboo, Kamloops, and Omineca Mining Divisions, or for any mineral therein:

(1) All those lands situated in the Cariboo Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the north-east corner of Lot 4041 (T.L. 8658'), Cariboo District thence due north to a point due east of the north-east corner of Lot 4942 (T.L. 8657'); thence due west to a point due north of the north-west corner of Lot 4843 (T.L. 8655'); thence south to the said north-west corner of Lot 4943; thence easterly and southerly along the north-west corner and easterly boundaries of said Lot 4843 to the most northerly and northerly boundaries of said Lot 4843; thence easterly along the north-west corner of Lot 4840 (T.L. 8656'); thence southerly along the northerly boundaries of Lots 4840 and 4941 to the north-east corner of said Lot 4841, being the point of commencement;

(2) All those lands situated in the Cariboo Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-west corner of Lot 3238, Cariboo District; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of said Lot 3238 to the most southerly south-east corner thereof; thence easterly in a straight line to the north-west corner of Lot 3237; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of said Lot 3237 to the south-east corner thereof; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Lot 3237 and the northerly prolongation thereof to a point due east of the north-east corner of Lot 4135; thence due west to a point due north of the north-west corner of Lot 3238; thence south to the said north-west corner of Lot 3238; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of said Lot 3238 to the south-west corner thereof, being the point of commencement;

(3) All those lands situated in Range 5, Coast Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-west corner of Lot 549, Range 5, Coast District; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of Lot 549 and 549A to the south-east corner of said Lot 549A; thence easterly in a straight line to the south-west corner of Lot 314; thence easterly, northerly and westerly along the southerly, easterly and northerly boundaries of said Lot 314 to the north-west corner thereof; thence due west to the easterly boundary of Lot 3117; thence northerly, westerly and southerly along the

boundaries of said lot 3017 to a point due east of the north-east corner of lot 552; thence west to the said north-east corner of lot 552; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said lot 552 to the north-west corner thereof; thence southerly along the westerly boundaries of lots 552 and 549 to the aforesaid south-west corner of lot 549, being the point of commencement;

(4) All those lands situated in the Kankopa Division of Yale Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-east corner of T.L. 5185<sup>r</sup>, Kankopa Division of Yale District; thence north-westerly in a straight line to the north-west corner of said T.L. 5185<sup>r</sup>; thence north-westerly in a straight line to the south-west corner of T.L. 9229<sup>r</sup>; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of said T.L. 9229<sup>r</sup> to the north-east corner thereof; thence south-easterly in a straight line to the intersection of the easterly prolongation of the southerly boundary of aforesaid T.L. 5185<sup>r</sup> with the edge of the bed of the Clearwater River on the right bank thereof; thence westerly in a straight line to the south-east corner of said T.L. 5185<sup>r</sup>, being the point of commencement;

(5) All those lands situated in the Kankopa Division of Yale Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the north-west corner of lot 2716, Kankopa Division of Yale District; thence northerly in a straight line to the south-east corner of T.L. 4033<sup>r</sup>; thence due east to a point due north of the north-east corner of lot 2715; thence southerly in a straight line to the said north-east corner of lot 2715; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of said lot 2715 to a point due east of the north-east corner of aforesaid lot 2716; thence west to the said north-east corner; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said lot 2716 to the aforesaid north-west corner thereof, being the point of commencement.

(6) All those lands situated in the Kankopa Division of Yale Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-east corner of lot 2174, Kankopa Division of Yale District; thence northerly and westerly along the easterly and northerly boundaries of lots 2174 and 2177 to the south-east corner of lot 2180; thence northerly along the easterly boundary of lots 2180 and 3045 to the north-east corner of said lot 3045; thence westerly along the northerly boundaries of lots 3045, 3046 and 3049 to the north-west corner of said lot 3049; thence due west 1/4 mile; thence due south to a point due west of the south-west corner of aforesaid lot 2174; thence east to the said south-west corner of lot 2174; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of said lot 2174 to the aforesaid south-east corner thereof, being the point of commencement;

(7) All those lands situated in the Kankopa Division of Yale Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the most southerly south-east corner of lot 1725, Kankopa Division of Yale District; being a point on the edge of the bed of the Clearwater River on the right bank thereof; thence due north to the northerly boundary of said lot 1725; thence due east to a point due north of the north-west corner of lot 4097; thence south to the said north-west corner of lot 4097; thence southerly along the westerly boundaries of lots 1097 and 4095 and the southerly prolongation thereof to a point due east of the point of commencement; thence west to the said point of commencement;

(8) All the lands situated in the "Amloop" Division of Yale Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-west corner of lot 2162, Kamloops Division of Yale District; thence northerly along the easterly boundaries of lot 2161, 2164 and 2165 to the north-east corner of said lot 2165; thence westerly along the northerly boundaries of said lot 2165 to the north-west corner thereof; thence due west a distance of  $\frac{3}{4}$  miles; thence due south to a point due west of the point of commencement; thence east to the said point of commencement;

(9) All those lands situated in the Kamloops Division of Yale Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the north-west corner of lot 3889, Kamloops Division of Yale District; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of said lot 3889 to the south-west corner thereof; thence due south for a distance of  $\frac{1}{4}$  miles; thence due east to a point due south of the south-east corner of lot 2956F; thence north to the said south-east corner of lot 2956F; thence northerly and westerly along the easterly and northerly boundaries of lots 2956F and 3889 to the north-west corner of said lot 3889; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of said lot 3889 to the north-east corner of lot 3889; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said lot 3889 to the aforesaid north-west corner thereof, being the point of commencement;

(10) All those lands situated in the Cariboo Land District being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the mouth of Limestone Creek on the Cariboo River, Cariboo District, thence due east for one-quarter mile; thence north  $25^{\circ}$  east for one and one-half miles; thence north  $37^{\circ}$  west for one-quarter mile; thence south  $52^{\circ}$  west for one and one-half miles; thence south  $35^{\circ}$  east to point of commencement;

except in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) That any free miner who locates a placer claim or mineral claim and obtains a record thereof or who obtains a placer lease or a mineral lease shall do so at his own risk and shall not interfere or allow any person exploring, developing, mining, or working in any way the said claim or lodehold to obstruct or to interfere in any manner with the exercise of any right, whether existing or subsequently granted, of any other person to flood, or to occupy for any purpose connected with the development of hydro-electric power, the areas reserved, to construct, operate and maintain any work done or structure erected for any of the foregoing purposes and the free miner shall not be entitled to compensation for any damage which may be done to his mining operation, plant or equipment by the aforesaid exercise of any right whether existing or subsequently granted;
- (2) No free miner shall carry on any mining operation within fifteen hundred feet of any dam, conduit, water tunnel, siltway or power plant, or within five hundred feet of any transmission line or any other work or structure which may be erected in the areas reserved except with the permission of the Chief Inspector of Mines.
- (3) A person including the Crown or its agent, who builds or proposes to build a dam, conduit, water tunnel, or power plant, or transmission line, or any ways, works, or structures in the areas reserved shall not interfere with or dislocate or obstruct any existing mining operation, plant, or equipment without:

- (a) Inserting an advertisement of such intention in one issue of the British Columbia Gazette and in one issue of a newspaper circulating in the district in which the reserved areas are situated, not less than thirty days nor more than ninety days before the actual start of the work or operation which will result in such interference, dislocation or obstruction takes place; and
- (b) Giving at least ninety days notice in writing to the owner or holder of a mineral claim, lease or placer-mining claim, as the case may be, or his representative, which notice shall be deemed to have been sufficiently given if it is mailed to the address noted upon the last tax notice issued in respect of a Crown-granted mineral claim or noted in the most recent relevant record of the Gold Commissioner, and any notice so given shall be deemed to have been received when, in the ordinary course of mail, it should have been delivered. No notice under this term or condition need be delivered to a free miner or lessee, or his representative, who records a placer claim or a mineral claim or applies for a mineral lease or files a notice of intention to apply for a placer-mining lease after the insertion of the advertisements required by paragraph (3) (a) above;

- (4) The benefit of the conditions set forth in this order inures to the Crown and its agents, to persons contracting with the Crown with respect to the development of the areas reserved and to licensees under the "Water Act";

- (5) The free miner shall before making application to record a placer claim or a mineral claim or before making application for a mineral lease or filing a notice of intention to apply for a placer lease, execute and deliver to the Gold Commissioner a release, in quadruplicate, in favour of Her Majesty in the right of Her Province of British Columbia, and licensees, assignees, agents and servants, from any cause of action, claim, demand or action, which he may at any time have or allege as the result of any exploration, development, mining or working of any area which may be included in a placer claim, a mineral claim, a placer lease or a mineral lease or as the result of occupation of any level for any purpose connected with the development of hydro-electric power or as the result of any structure, operation, or maintenance of any work done or structure erected for any of the purposes set forth in paragraph (1).
