The undersigned has the honour to recommend that Order in Council No. 2302, approved on September 11th, 1961, be cancelled:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT pursuant to Subsection 5 of Section 12 of the Mineral Act, Chapter 244, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960 and Section 11 of the Placer-Mining Act, Chapter 285, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960, no person shall enter, locate, prospect or mine upon the following described lands in the Liard Mining Division:-

All those lands in the Peace River Land District lying between longitude 121 degrees 53 minutes west and longitude 121 degrees 55 minutes west and latitude 56 degrees 03 minutes 30 seconds north and latitude 56 degrees 05 minutes north.


