The undersigned has the honour to recommend that pursuant to the Placer-Mining Act and Mineral Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may enter, locate, prospect or mine for any mineral in the following described area:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Section 3, Township 19, Range 27, West 6th Meridian, thence north 16 miles to the northwest corner of Section 22, Township 21, Range 27, West 6th Meridian, thence east 6 miles to the northeast corner of Section 21, Township 21, Range 26, West 6th Meridian, thence south 16 miles to the southeast corner of Section 4, Township 19, Range 26, West 6th Meridian, thence west 6 miles to the afore-said southwest corner of Section 3, Township 19, Range 27, West 6th Meridian, being the point of commencement:

Excluding therefrom the following described lands:-

Upper Hat Creek Indian Reserve No. 1 and the east half and east half of the west half of Sections 1 and 12, Township 21, Range 27, West 6th Meridian, and the west half of sections 6 and 7, Township 21, Range 26, West 6th Meridian.
