recommend that, pursuant to subsection (5) of Section 12 of the "Mineral Act", Chapter 244, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960, as amended by Chapter 39, Statutes of British Columbia, 1961, and Chapter 39, Statutes of British Columbia, 1962, and Section 11 of the "Placer-Mining Act", Chapter 285, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960, no person may locate or mine upon the following described areas in the Nanaimo Mining Division for any mineral therein:-

That part of Lot 190 (Pulp Lease), Rupert District, more particularly described as follows: commencing at the northwest corner of said Lot 190, being a point on the easterly high water mark of Neroutsos Inlet; thence easterly, southerly, easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly boundaries of said Lot 190 to the most westerly southwest corner of Special Timber Licence 13204<sup>P</sup>; thence due south to the said easterly high water mark of Neroutsos Inlet; thence north-westerly along the said high water mark to the point of commencement and containing 450 acres more or less;

The most southerly 20 chains of the most westerly 20 chains of Special Timber Licence 621<sup>P</sup> situated in Rupert District and containing 40 acres more or less.
