MEMO

DEPARTMENT OF MINES AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES

The Order being rescinded is redundant. It was superseded by Order in Council No. 419, approved on February 25, 1956. The latter order placed a reserve over the same lands but allowed mining within the area reserved, subject to certain conditions. Order 1468 was an outright reservation.

The area concerned is the right-of-way for the Westcoast gas transmission line from Taylor Flats to Vancouver.
