The undersigned has the honour to recommend that, pursuant to subsection (5) of Section 12 of the "Mineral Act", Chapter 244, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960, as amended by Chapter 39, Statutes of British Columbia, 1961, and Chapter 39, Statutes of British Columbia, 1962, and Section 11 of the "Placer-Mining Act", Chapter 285, Revised Statutes of British Columbia, 1960, no person may locate or mine upon the following described area in the Skeena Mining Division for any mineral therein:-


Commencing at the North East corner of Lot 446, Range 5, Coast District, being a point on the Southerly high-water-mark of Wainright Basin; thence in a general North Easterly direction along the high-water-marks of Wainright Basin, Morse Basin, Kloiya Bay, and Denise Inlet to the most Easterly point on the high-water mark at the head of said Denise Inlet; thence North Easterly along a straight line drawn to a point on the Westerly boundary of Lot 197, 5 chains Southerly from the North West corner thereof to the Easterly boundary of the watershed of Prudhomme Lake; thence in a general Southerly direction along the Easterly boundaries of the watersheds of Prudhomme Lake and Rainbow Lake to the Easterly boundary of Lot 3079; thence Southerly along the said Easterly boundary of Lot 3079 to the South East corner thereof; thence Westerly along the Southerly boundaries of Lots 3079 and 4010 to the South West corner of said Lot 4010; thence Southerly along the Westerly boundary of Lot 3080 to the South West corner thereof; thence Westerly along the Northerly boundaries of Lots 2231 and 2230 to the South East corner of Lot 2229; thence Northerly along the Easterly boundary of said Lot 2229 to the South East corner of the North half thereof; thence Westerly along the Southerly boundary of the said North half of Lot 2229 to the South West corner of the said North half; thence Southerly along the Westerly boundary of said Lot 2229 to the Southerly boundary of the watershed of Diana Lake; thence in a general North Westerly direction along the said Southerly boundary of the watershed of Diana Lake and the Northerly boundary of the watershed of Inverness Passage to the Easterly boundary of Lot 647; thence Northerly and Westerly along the Easterly and Northerly

boundaries of said Lot 647 to the North West corner thereof, being a point on the Easterly boundary of aforesaid Lot 446; thence Northerly along the said Easterly boundary of Lot 446 to the North East corner thereof, being the point of commencement.
