The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and the Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Omineca Mining Division, Range 5, Coast Land District:

Commencing at a point 1,300 feet due east of Survey Hub 30, established by the Department of Fisheries and shown on plan of Babine Lake Development (drawing No. 21-18-64) dated November 20th, 1964; thence due west 1,300 feet to said Survey Hub 30; thence due west 1,600 feet; thence due north 660 feet; thence due west 900 feet; thence due north to the southerly high water mark of Babine Lake; thence in a general easterly direction along the said high water mark of Babine Lake to a point due north of the point of commencement; thence due south to the said point of commencement.
