The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Omineca Mining Division, Range 5, Coast Land District:

Commencing at a point on the westerly limit, situated at station 180+00, on the #118 Topley Landing Road (as under construction) as shown on a plan approved by the Regional Engineer, Department of Highways, on December 29th, 1967; thence south 43° 14' 20" west 2,060 feet; thence south 46° 45' 40" east 2,300 feet; thence north 43° 14' 20" east 1,000 feet more or less to the aforesaid westerly limit; thence northwesterly along the said westerly limit to the point of commencement; containing approximately 65 acres.
