The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the New Westminster Mining Division, Yale Division of Yale Land District:

Firstly -- all that portion of the bed of the Fraser River within Section 8, Township 5, Range 26, West of the 6th Meridian, which lies to the north of a line drawn South 55° East from the southwest corner of Fractional Legal Subdivision 13 of said Section 8;

Secondly -- all that portion of the bed of the Fraser River within the West one-half of Section 9, Range 26, West of the 6th Meridian;

Thirdly -- all that portion of the bed of the Fraser River being a strip of foreshore parallel to and perpendicularly distant 300 feet southerly from the right bank thereof, and lying within the Fractional northeast one-quarter of Section 2, and the Fractional southwest one-quarter of Section 11, Township 5, Range 27, West of the 6th Meridian.
