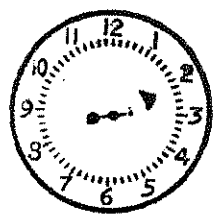

THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereto enabling, no person may locate or mine upon the following area in the Omineca and Liard Mining Divisions for any minerals therein:

An area 10 miles wide, being 5 miles on each side of the proposed right-of-way for the Pacific Great Eastern Railway commencing at the junction of Leo Creek with Takla Lake, thence along the easterly shore of Takla Lake and the valleys of Driftwood River, Bear River, Sastut River, Skeana River and Klappan River to its junction with Stikine River as shown on plan attached:

except in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions:

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above, shall be entitled to any surface rights in and along the right-of-way to be used by the said railway nor where any area is used for construction, road, power line or structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease as a result of the building of the railway:

No holder of a mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above, or any person exploring, developing, mining or working in any way the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease, shall be entitled to any claim for damage which may be caused by any construction, operation and maintenance of a railway bed, road or power line or structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim, or placer-mining claim or lease as a result of the building of the railway.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT upon the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease which lies within the area outlined above, the lands covered by any such mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease shall become and are hereby constituted a reservation under the terms of this Order.
