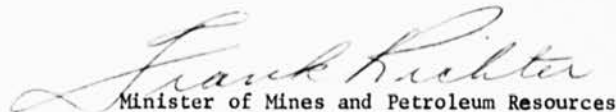
The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the New Westminster Mining Division, Yale Land District:

Commencing at a point on the high water mark of Chilliwack Lake, said point being on the north west corner of D.L. 1073; thence easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly boundaries of said D.L. 1073 to the south east corner thereof; thence south 20 chains; thence south easterly in a straight line 150 chains more or less to boundary monument 64 on the International Boundary; thence westerly 350 chains more or less along the said International Boundary to the height of land immediately adjacent to monument 60; thence northerly and easterly along the said height of land to the summit of Mount Lindeman; thence north 77° 35', east 147 chains more or less to a point on the aforesaid high water mark of Chilliwack Lake on the westerly shore thereof; thence southerly, easterly and northerly along said high water mark of Chilliwack Lake to the north west corner of aforesaid D.L. 1073, being the point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
