The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend

CANC. JC 2774/73

THAT pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Greenwood Mining Division, Similkameen Division of Yale Land District:

Commencing at a point on the southwest corner of Lot 1886S; thence west 32 chains; thence north 13° east 220 chains; thence north 40° east 70 chains; thence south 52° east 100 chains; thence south 23° west 220 chains more or less to a point due east of the most southerly southeast corner of aforesaid Lot 1886S; thence west to the said southeast corner; thence westerly along the southerly boundary of Lot 1886S to the southwest corner thereof, being the point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
