THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Victoria Mining Division, Cowichan Lake Lead District:

That part of Block 229 more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the most southerly southeast corner of Block 165, being a point on the westerly boundary of Block 229; thence northerly along the said westerly boundary of Block 229 a distance of 10 chains; thence due east 30 chains; thence due south 25 chains; thence due west 30 chains more or less to the aforesaid westerly boundary of Block 229; thence northerly along the said westerly boundary of Block 229 to the aforesaid most southerly southeast corner of Block 165, being the point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
