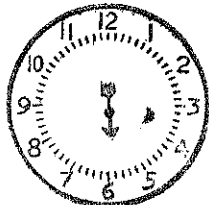

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Nicola Mining Division, Kamloops Land District:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 4253; thence westerly along the southerly boundary of said Lot 4253 to the southwest corner thereof; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of Lot 4821 to its intersection with the high water mark on the northeasterly shore of Pennask Lake; thence southerly in a straight line to the northeast corner of Lot 4834, being a point on the high water mark of the southerly shore of Pennask Lake; thence southerly and westerly along the easterly and southerly boundaries of Lot 4834 to the southwest corner of said Lot 4834, being a point on the high water mark on the easterly shore of Pennask Lake; thence in a general southwesterly direction along the said high water mark on the easterly shore of Pennask Lake to the northeast corner of Lot 3759; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of Lot 3759 a distance of 5 chains; thence due east to a point on the high water mark on the westerly shore of Peterson Lake; thence northerly along the said high water mark on the westerly shore of Peterson Lake to the southeast corner of Lot 5882; thence westerly and northerly along the southerly and westerly boundaries of said Lot 5882 to the northwest corner thereof; thence westerly and northerly along the southerly and westerly boundaries of Lot 4252 to the northwest corner thereof; thence northerly in a straight line to the southeast corner of the aforesaid Lot 4253, being the point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any areas comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
