THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Liard Mining Division, Peace River Land District:

Commencing at a point located 16 chains west and 46 chains south of the southeast corner of Lot 1562, Peace River Land District; thence due west a distance of 240 chains; thence due south a distance of 348 chains; thence due east a distance of 120 chains more or less to the easterly boundary of Stone Mountain Park; thence in a northeasterly direction along the said park boundary to a point due south of the point of commencement; thence due north 158 chains more or less to the point of commencement:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
