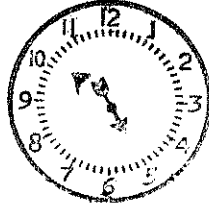

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Rupert Land District;

Commencing at a point on the natural boundary of Marble River on the left bank thereof, said point being 26 chains due south and 77 chains due west of the most southerly point on the natural boundary of Sara Lake; thence due west 11 chains; thence due north to the natural boundary of Marble River on the left bank thereof; thence in a generally easterly and southerly direction along the said natural boundary of Marble River to the aforesaid point of commencement.

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
