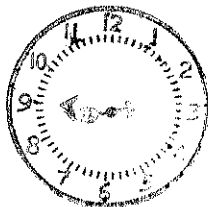

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Trail Creek Mining Division, Kootenay Land District:

Commencing at the most easterly southeast corner of Lot 1344 (Mascott); thence southwesterly and northwesterly along the southeasterly and southwesterly boundaries of said Lot 1344 to the southerly boundary of Lot 1197 (St. Lawrence); thence westerly along said southerly boundary of Lot 1197 to the easterly boundary of the municipality of Rossland; thence southerly along said municipal boundary a distance of 375 feet; thence due east 1,325 feet $\frac{1}{2}$ to a point due south of the most westerly southwest corner of Lot 1298 (Mascot Fraction); thence due north to said southwest corner of Lot 1298; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Lot 1298 to the southeast corner of Lot 1344, that being the point of commencement:

and

Lot 3287 (East Columbia Mountain Fraction).

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
