

To His Honour

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council:

The undersigned has the honour to recommend

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Victoria Mining Division, Cowichan Land District:

Commencing at a point 10 chains East and 6 chains South of the Northeast corner of Lot 26; thence West 30 chains; thence South 19 chains; thence East 30 chains; thence North 19 chains more or less to the point of commencement.


AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
