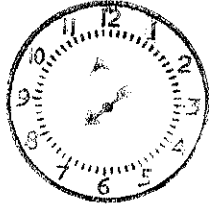

THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Omineca Mining Division, Cassiar Land District:

Commencing at the intersection of the 57° 00' parallel of North latitude with the 124° 15' meridian of West longitude; thence due North 200 chains; thence due West 160 chains; thence due South 200 chains; thence due East 160 chains to the point of commencement:

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
