THAT pursuant to the Mineral and Placer-mining Acts and all other powers thereunto enabling, no person may locate or mine in or upon the following described lands in the Liard Mining Division, Cassiar Land District:

Commencing at a point a distance of 16 chains due west of the northwest corner of Lot 6903; thence due north a distance of 40 chains; thence due east a distance of 116 chains; thence due south a distance of 152 chains; thence due west a distance of 116 chains more or less to a point due south of the point of commencement; thence north to said point of commencement;

AND TO FURTHER RECOMMEND THAT on and after the expiry of any mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within those lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order come into operation with respect to each such location upon such expiry.
