EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 23. APR. 1974

RF Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (1) No person may locate a mineral claim, placer-mining claim or placer-mining lease in or upon the following described lands in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Rupert Land District, in the period commencing on the date of approval of this Order and terminating December 31, 1975:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 477 (T.L. 10198^P), Rupert District; thence westerly and southerly along the northerly and westerly boundaries of Lot 477 to the southerly boundary of the watershed of an unnamed tributary of Compton Creek (the confluence of said unnamed creek being 22 chains South and 21 chains East of the northwest corner of Lot 477); thence generally westerly along said southerly watershed boundary to the southerly boundary of the watershed of Montague Creek; thence generally westerly along the southerly watershed boundary of Montague Creek to the southeasterly boundary of the watershed of Kunnum Creek; thence generally southwesterly along the southeasterly watershed boundary of Kunnum Creek to the summit of Mt. Cain; thence south in a straight line to the summit of Maquilla Peak; thence southeasterly along the northeasterly boundary of the watershed of Maquilla Creek to the northwesterly boundary of the watershed of White River; thence northeasterly along the northwesterly watershed boundary of White River to the most easterly point on the watershed boundary of an unnamed tributary of Adams River (the confluence of said unnamed tributary and Adams River, being 20 chains north and 9 chains east of the southeast corner of Lot 477 (T.L. 10198^P); thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said watershed boundary to the south boundary of Lot 477; thence easterly and northerly along the southerly and easterly boundaries of Lot 477 to the northeast corner thereof, that being the point of commencement.

- (2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining

claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location during the aforesaid period, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.

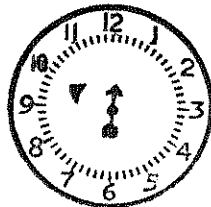
