EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 14 NOV 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the Vancouver Mining Division, Range 1, Coast Land District:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 38, thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Lot 38 a distance of 5 chains; thence due west 60 chains; thence due south 40 chains; thence due east 60 chains more or less to a point due south of the aforesaid southeast corner of Lot 38; thence north 35 chains more or less to said corner, being the point of commencement;

and

- (2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.

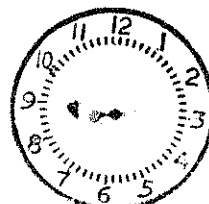
