EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 14 NOV 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Rupert Land District:

Commencing at a point 10 chains due south of the most northerly northeast corner of T.L. 10124P; thence due east 12 chains; thence due south 12 chains; thence due west 14 chains; thence due north 12 chains; thence east 2 chains more or less to said point of commencement.

and

(2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim, or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.

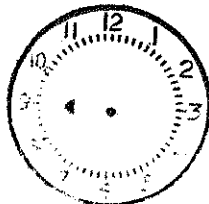
