EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 14 NOV 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot 5265; thence easterly along the southerly boundary of said Lot 5265 a distance of 20 chains; thence due south to the southerly boundary of Lot 2477; thence westerly along the southerly boundaries of Lots 2477 and 1969 to the southwest corner of Block 28, New Westminster District, Plan 4216, deposited in Land Registry Office Vancouver; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Block 28 to the northwest corner thereof; thence northerly in a straight line to the southwest corner of Block 21, said Plan 4216; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Block 21 to the northwest corner thereof; thence northerly in a straight line to the southwest corner of Block 12, said Plan 4216; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Block 12 to the northwest corner thereof; thence northerly in a straight line to the southwest corner of Block 5, said Plan 4216; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said Block 5 to the northwest corner thereof, being a point on the northerly boundary of aforesaid Lot 1969; thence easterly along the said northerly boundary of Lot 1969 to the westerly boundary of aforesaid Lot 5265; thence southerly along the said westerly boundary of Lot 5265 to the aforesaid southwest corner thereof, being the point of commencement.

and

- (2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
