EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 14 NOV 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- Km*
(1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the New Westminster Mining Division, Yale Division of Yale Land District:

Commencing at a point 13 chains due north and 45 chains due east of the southwest corner of Section 5, Township 2, Range 27, West of the 6th Meridian; thence South 12 degrees East 5 chains more or less to the northerly limit of the public trail commonly known and referred to as the Centennial Trail; thence in a general westerly direction along the said northerly limit of the Centennial Trail to it's intersection with the southerly boundary of aforesaid Section 5; thence westerly along the said southerly boundary of Section 5 to the natural boundary of an unnamed lake on the northerly shore thereof, said unnamed lake located 7 chains more or less east of the southwest corner of said Section 5; thence in a general westerly direction along the said natural boundary of the unnamed lake on the northerly shore thereof to a point thereon 13 chains due east and 1 chain due north of the southwest corner of said Section 5; thence North 34 degrees East 11 chains; thence North 80 degrees East 14 chains more or less to the aforesaid natural boundary of Chilliwack River on the left bank thereof; thence in a general easterly direction along the said natural boundary of Chilliwack River on the left bank thereof to the aforesaid point of commencement.

and

- (2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
