Executive Council Chambers, Victoria 14. NOV. 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the Victoria Mining Division, Cowichan Lake Land District:

Commencing at the most northerly northwest corner of Block 289, being also a point on the southerly boundary of Block 372; thence northwesterly along the said southerly boundary of Block 372 a distance of 10 chains, thence due north 19 chains; thence due east 34 chains; thence due south 22 chains more or less to the aforesaid southerly boundary of Block 372; thence westerly along the said southerly boundary of Block 372 to the aforesaid most northerly northwest corner of Block 289, being the point of commencement.

and

(2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or lease the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.
