EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 14 NOV 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person shall locate or mine upon the following described lands in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Rupert Land District:

Commencing at a point 16 chains due east and 14 chains due south of the southwest corner of Section 10, Township 18; thence due south 7 chains; thence due east 15 chains; thence due north 7 chains; thence west 15 chains more or less to said point of commencement.

and

(2) On and after the expiry of any existing mineral claim, placer-mining claim or least the location of which lies within these lands, no person may locate or mine in or upon any area comprised in the location, and that this Order comes into operation with respect to each such location upon expiry.

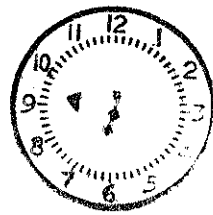
