EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA DEC. 3 1974

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

(1) No person shall locate upon any of the lands within the following described area in the Liard and Cariboo Mining Divisions, Peace River and Cariboo Land District, in the period commencing on the date of approval of this Order and terminating December 31, 1976:

Commencing at a point 0.5 miles south and 3.6 miles west, more or less, of the south-east corner of Lot 1476, Peace River Land District, said point being on the southerly edge of a road right-of-way, and being on the height of land between the Murray River drainage and the Kinuseo Creek drainage; thence due west 0.3 miles, more or less, to a point on the centre line of an unnamed creek, said creek being the first creek north of Kinuseo Falls draining into the right bank of the Murray River; thence in a northwesterly direction along the centre line of said unnamed creek to a point at said creek's confluence with the Murray River; thence due west to a point 0.25 miles from the natural boundary of the left bank of the Murray River; thence parallel to said natural boundary or the left bank of the Murray River, in a southerly direction to a point on the natural boundary of the left bank of Imperial Creek; thence in a westerly and southerly direction along said natural boundary of the left bank of Imperial Creek to the most westerly point of an unnamed lake at the headwater of Imperial Creek; thence due west 0.5 miles, more or less, to the height of land that marks the boundary between the Peace River Land District and the Cariboo Land District; thence in an easterly and southerly direction along said boundary to a point being the intersection between said boundary and the height of land between the Murray River drainage and the Wapiti River drainage; thence in a northerly direction along said height of land to a point on the height of land that separates the Murray River, Kinuseo Creek and Wapiti River drainages; thence continuing in a northerly direction along the height of land between the Murray River drainage and the Kinuseo Creek drainage to a point on the southerly edge of the aforementioned road right-of-way, the said point being the point of commencement.

(2) Upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act whose location falls within or partly within the above area, the lands of such location, including the minerals, contained in the said claims or leases which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation become subject to this order and no person shall locate upon such lands.

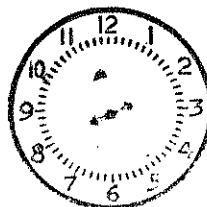
