EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA JUL. 31 1975

Pursuant to the Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the reserve established pursuant to Order in Council No. 643, approved February 19, 1971 covering several areas in the Cariboo Mining Division as shown on Map No. 1, File 172 in the office of the Chief Gold Commissioner, Department of Mines and Petroleum Resources, Victoria, be amended by deleting the following described area:

Commencing at the most southerly corner of Lot 11418; thence due west 50 chains; thence due north 78 chains more or less to the southerly boundary of a public road; thence South 45° East in a straight line 41 chains more or less to the said southerly boundary of the public road; thence in a general southeasterly direction along the said public road to a point due north of the most southerly corner of Lot 11418; thence due south 31 chains more or less to the said most southerly corner of Lot 11418, said point being the point of commencement.
