EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA MAY 1 1975

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (1) No person shall locate upon any of the lands within the following described area in the Lillooet Mining Division, Lillooet Land District, during the period commencing on the date this Order comes into force and terminating on April 1, 1980.

Commencing at a point 2,350 feet due west of the southeast corner of Lot 1041; thence due south 4.1 miles; thence due west 13.5 miles; thence north 7° west 10.75 miles; thence north 35° 30' east 2.75 miles; thence due east 13.35 miles more or less to a point 2.75 miles north 9° 30' east of northeast corner of Lot 1040; thence due south 8.85 miles more or less to a point 2,350 feet due west of the southeast corner of Lot 1041, being the point of commencement

and

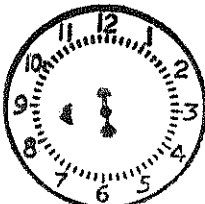
- (2) Upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in the right of the Province of any Crown-granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no person shall locate upon such lands.
