EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA FEB. 27 1975

R Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the description contained in Order in Council No. 3830 approved 4 December 1974 be deleted and the following description be substituted:


Commencing at the northeast corner of District Lot 817; thence due north in a straight line 225 chains more or less to the natural boundary of Murray River on the left bank thereof; thence due east in a straight line 305 chains more or less to the southwesterly boundary of the watershed of Kinuseo Creek; thence in a general southeasterly direction along the southwesterly boundary of the watershed of said Kinuseo Creek and continuing in a general southeasterly and westerly direction along the easterly and southerly boundary of the watershed of Bulley Creek to the southerly boundary of the watershed of the aforesaid Murray River; thence in a general westerly and northerly direction along the southerly boundary of the watershed of said Murray River and continuing in a general westerly and northerly direction along the southerly and westerly boundary of the watershed of Monkman Creek to an unnamed peak at a designated point located at $54^{\circ} 37' 51''$ N. Latitude and $121^{\circ} 22' 37''$ W. Longitude; thence due north in a straight line 440 chains more or less to the natural boundary of an unnamed creek on the left bank thereof, said unnamed creek flowing northwesterly into Imperial Creek; thence due east in a straight line 450 chains more or less to the easterly boundary of the watershed of Imperial Creek; thence in a general northerly direction along the easterly boundary of the watershed of said Imperial Creek to a point due south of the southeast corner of the aforesaid Lot 817; thence due north in a straight line 70 chains more or less to the southeast corner of said Lot 817; thence in a northerly direction along the easterly boundary of said Lot 817 to the northeast corner thereof, said point being the point of commencement.
