All that land lying within Township 23, Range 11, West 6 Meridian as described as follows:

1. The northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 13;
2. The southeast quarter and the south half of the northeast quarter of Section 23;
3. The southwest quarter of Section 24.

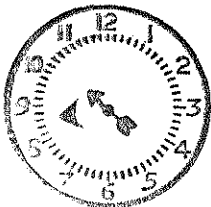
