EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA AUG. 19 1976

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that no person may locate or mine or develop or produce minerals or stake or acquire a location on any of the lands within the area described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof, which lands are situated in the Cariboo and Liard Mining Divisions, Cariboo and Peace River Land Districts; except in accordance with and subject to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. No holder of a mineral claim or lease issued under the Mineral and Placer Mining Acts that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above, shall be entitled to any surface rights in and along the right-of-way of any road, railway bed, power line, or structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim or lease as a result of the building of the road, railway bed, or power line.
2. No holder of a mineral claim or lease issued under the Mineral and Placer Mining Acts that may hereafter be located within the area outlined above or any person exploring, developing, mining or working in any way the said mineral claim or lease shall be entitled to any claim for damage which may be caused by any construction, operation and maintenance of a railway bed, road or power line or structure of any kind whatsoever, which may come into existence on the said mineral claim or lease as a result of the building of the road, railway bed, or power line.
3. Upon the expiry of any mineral claim or lease which lies within the area outlined above, the lands covered by any such mineral claim or lease shall become and are hereby constituted a reservation under the terms of this Order.

AND FURTHER ORDERS THAT the lands within the area described in Schedule "A" are hereby designated placer reserves under the Placer Mining Act.

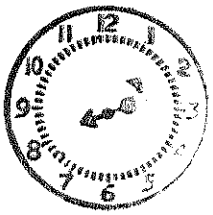

Schedule "A" which forms part of Order in Council No. _____

Commencing at the point latitude 54°30' north, longitude 120°30' west; thence due north along the said 120°30' meridian of west longitude to the intersection with the 55°45' parallel of north latitude; thence due west along the said 55°45' parallel of north latitude to the intersection with the 121°00' meridian of west longitude; thence due south along the said 121°00' meridian of west longitude to the intersection with the 55°30' parallel of north latitude; thence due west along the said 55°30' parallel of north latitude to the intersection with the 121°30' meridian of west longitude; thence due north along the said 121°30' meridian of west longitude to the intersection with the 55°42' parallel of north latitude; thence due west along the said 55°42' parallel of north latitude to the intersection with the 121°45' meridian of west longitude; thence due south along the said 121°45' meridian of west longitude to the intersection with the 55°30' parallel of north latitude; thence due west along the said 55°30' parallel of north latitude to the intersection with the 122°00' meridian of west longitude; thence due south along the said 122°00' meridian of west longitude to the intersection with the 54°48' parallel of north latitude; thence due west along the said 54°48' parallel of north latitude to the intersection with the 122°44' meridian of west longitude; thence due south along the said 122°44' meridian of west longitude to the intersection with the 54°30' parallel of north latitude; thence due east along the said 54°30' parallel of north latitude to the intersection with the 120°30' meridian of west longitude, being the point of commencement.
