EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA NOV. 4 1976

Pursuant to the Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the following described area in the Kamloops Mining Division, Kamloops and District be and is hereby designated as designated placer land.

"Commencing at a point 200 metres (656.17 feet) south of the northwest corner of Lot 3393, said point being the westerly boundary of Lot 3393; thence due west 1000 metres (3280.83 feet); thence due south 500 metres (1640.42 feet); thence due east 1000 metres (3280.83 feet) more or less to the westerly boundary of said Lot 3393; thence due north to a point 200 metres (656.17 feet) due south of the northwest corner of Lot 3393, being the point of commencement."

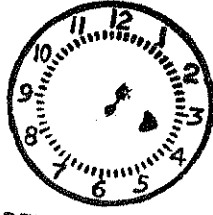
