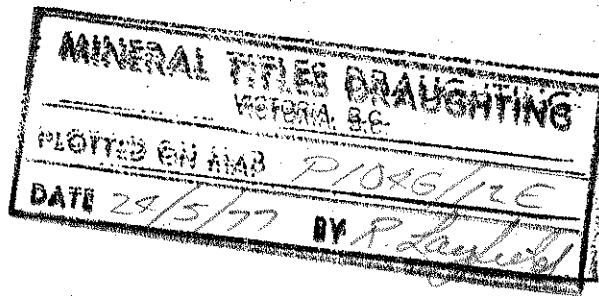

An area being 1 000 m either side of the center line of the Barrington River from the confluence of the said Barrington River and the Chutine River to a point 4 000 m upstream on the said Barrington River.

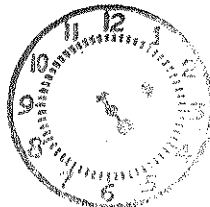
