EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 23. JUN. 1977

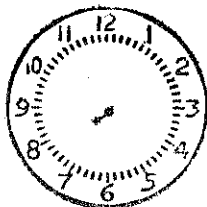
Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that Administrator

- (1) no person shall record or locate upon and no free miner shall stake on any of the lands within the areas described in Schedule "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof which lands are situated in the Atlin Mining Division, Cassiar Land District;
- (2) upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in right of the Province of any Crown-granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no person shall record or locate upon and no free miner shall stake on such lands;

and

- (3) with respect to the Placer Mining Act the lands described in Schedule "A" are hereby designated as placer reserves.

Schedule "A"

Forms part of Order in Council No.

a. Commencing at a point on the International Boundary 1 000 m southeast of Monument 120; thence easterly along the southerly watershed boundary of Lindeman Lake to Triangulation Station Fraser (G) elevation 5610 feet; thence due north to the centre line of the White Pass and Yukon Railway; thence northerly along the said centre line to Triangulation Station Bennet S.B. (G) elevation 2161 feet; thence due West to the high water mark of Bennett Lake; thence westerly along the said high water mark of Bennett Lake to the most northerly boundary of Lot 31; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said Lot 31 to the northwest corner thereof; thence due West 2 000 m; thence S35°W 6 000 m more or less to the northerly watershed boundary of Lindeman Lake; thence westerly along the said northerly boundary of the watershed of Lindeman Lake to the International Boundary; thence southeasterly along the said International Boundary to the point of commencement.

b. Commencing at Monument 118 of the International Boundary; thence due North 600 m; thence due East 2 500 m; thence South 35° East 2 200 m; thence South 55° West 800 m more or less to the International Boundary; thence northwesterly along the said International Boundary to the point of commencement.
