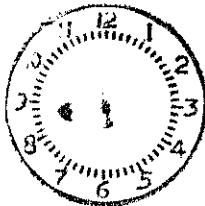

EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA 23. NOV. 1977

Pursuant to the Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the following described area in the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, be and is hereby designated as designated placer land.

Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 9789; thence due west 2 km; thence due north 1.1 km more or less to the natural boundary of the left bank of the Fraser River; thence easterly on the said natural boundary of the Fraser River to a point due north of the southeast corner of Lot 9789; thence due south to the said southeast corner of Lot 9789, being the point of commencement.
