EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA AUG. 10.1978

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer Mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Lieutenant Governor~~ *Administrator*, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- (1) no free miner shall record or locate upon and no free miner shall stake on or acquire a location in or on any of the lands within the following described area in the Kamloops Mining Division, Kamloops Division of Yale Land District:

Commencing at the southwest corner of the Fractional Section 21, Township 25, Range 7, West of the 6th Meridian; thence north 885 m; thence east 121 m; thence south 402 m; thence east 604 m, more or less, to the natural boundary of Hunakwa Lake on the westerly shore thereof; thence southerly and northeasterly along said natural boundary of Hunakwa Lake to a point on said natural boundary 201 m north and 241 m east, more or less, of the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 22, Township 25, Range 7, West of the 6th Meridian; thence east 764 m; thence southerly 805 m, more or less, to the northeast corner of Lot 707; thence southerly along the east boundary of Lot 707 and its extension to the natural boundary of the north shore of Anstey Arm, Shuswap Lake; thence westerly along said natural boundary to its intersection with the west boundary of Lot 707; thence west 1005 m; thence northerly 1210 m more or less, to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of Fractional Section 21, Township 25, Range 7, West of the 6th Meridian; thence westerly on the south boundary of the said Fractional Section 21 to the southwest corner thereof, being the point of commencement.

- (2) upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, 2 post claim, mining lease, certified mining lease, placer lease or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in right of the Province of any Crown-granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no free miner shall record or locate upon and no free miner shall stake on such lands;




