EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA JUL 26.1979

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- 1. No free miner shall
 - (a) record or locate a mineral claim, or
 - (b) stake or acquire a location
 on the area in the Liard Mining Division, Peace River Land District:

Commencing at a monument at the most northerly northwest corner of Block A of Lot 754; thence east 150 m along the north boundary of said Block A of Lot 754 to its intersection with a seismic survey line; thence N 20° 37' 11" W in a straight line along said seismic survey line 2 012 m; thence due west 543 m, more or less, to a point on the natural boundary of Williston Lake; thence generally southerly and easterly along said natural boundary of Williston Lake to a point due west of I.P. 120 as shown on plan 5T844, being a point on the west boundary of the above-mentioned Block A of Lot 754; thence due east to said I.P. 120; thence northeasterly along said west boundary of Block A of Lot 754 to the point of commencement.

- 2. In respect to the Placer Mining Act, the lands referred to in section 1 are a placer reserve.
