SCHEDULE "A"

Commencing at the northeast corner of section 24, Township 82, being a point on the natural boundary of the Fraser River on the right bank thereof; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said section 24 to the north west corner thereof; thence southerly along the westerly boundaries of sections 24, 13 and 12, Township 82, to the north east corner of Block "A" of the south east 1/4 of section 11, Township 82; thence southwesterly along the northwesterly boundary of aid Block "A" to the northerly boundary of section 2, Township 82; thence westerly, southerly and easterly along the northerly, westerly and southerly boundaries of the north east 1/4 of said section 2 to the south east corner thereof; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of said section 2 to the north west corner of lot 1 of lot 1061 as shown on plan 25036, deposited in the Land Registry Office at Kamloops; thence southerly along the westerly boundary of said lot 1 of lot 1061 and the easterly boundary of lot 2292 to the south east corner thereof; thence in a general southwesterly direction along the southeasterly boundary of said lot 2292 to the easterly boundary of lot 345; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of said lot 345 to the north east corner of lot 1 of lot 345 as shown on plan 25035, deposited in the Land Registry Office at Kamloops; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said lot 1 to the north west corner thereof; thence westerly along the most northerly southerly boundary of said lot 345 to the north east corner of lot 1 of lot 1063 as shown on plan 25033, deposited in the Land Registry Office at Kamloops; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of said lot 1 to the south east corner of lot 2291; thence in a general north westerly direction along the southwesterly boundary of said lot 2291 to the south east corner of lot 1 of lot 44 as shown on plan 25034, deposited in the Land Registry Office at Kamloops; thence northerly, westerly and southerly along the easterly, northerly and westerly boundaries of said lot 1 to a point on the natural boundary of the Chilcotin River, on the left bank thereof; thence in a general southeasterly direction along said natural boundary of the Chilcotin River to and continuing northerly along the natural boundary of the Fraser River on the right bank thereof to the aforementioned point of commencement.
