EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA OCT. 29. 1980

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- 1. No free miner shall
 - (a) record or locate a mineral claim, or
 - (b) stake or acquire a location
 on the following area in the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the natural boundary of the Quesnel River on the left bank thereof with the westerly boundary of lot 862; thence due south 200 m; thence due west 1 000 m; thence due north 200 m, more or less, to the natural boundary of the Quesnel River on the left bank thereof; thence in a general easterly direction along the said natural boundary of the Quesnel River on the left bank thereof to the point of intersection of the westerly boundary of lot 862 with the said natural boundary of the Quesnel River on the left bank thereof being the point of commencement.

- 2. In respect to the Mining (Placer) Act, the lands referred to in Section 1 are a placer reserve.
