On the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Lieutenant-Governor~~ ^{Administrator}, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that the following described areas be and are hereby designated as designated placer land.

- (1) In the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, an area 2 000 m wide, being 1 000 m on each side of the center line of McDougall River from a point on the center line of McDougall River, said point being 300 m upstream from the point of intersection of the center line of McDougall River and the center line of McLeod River to a point 6 000 m upstream on McDougall River from the point of intersection of the center line of McDougall River and the center line of Pyrite Creek.
- (2) In the Nelson and Trail Creek Mining Divisions, Kootenay Land District, commencing at the point of intersection of the easterly prolongation of the north boundary of lot 3384 and the natural boundary of the Columbia River on the right bank thereof; thence easterly along the said easterly prolongation of the north boundary of lot 3384 to the natural boundary of the Columbia River on the left bank thereof; thence generally southerly and southwesterly along the said natural boundary of the Columbia River to its point of intersection with the natural boundary of the Pend-d'Oreille River on the right bank thereof; thence southwesterly to the point of intersection of the natural boundary of the Columbia River on the left bank thereof with the natural boundary of the Pend-d'Oreille River on the left bank thereof; thence generally southwesterly along the said natural boundary of the Columbia River to the International Boundary between boundary monuments 180 and 181; thence westerly along the said International Boundary to the natural boundary of the Columbia River on the right bank thereof; thence generally northeasterly and northerly along the said natural boundary of the Columbia River to its point of intersection with an easterly prolongation of the north boundary of lot 3384, being the point of commencement.
