On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

MINERAL TITLES FILE ROOM

- 1. No free miner shall
 - (a) record or locate a mineral claim or
 - (b) stake or acquire a location
 on the following areas in the Cassiar Land District:

- A. In the Atlin Mining Division, commencing at the northeast corner of lot 6649; thence due north 730 m, more or less, to a point due west of the northwest corner of lot 5643; thence due east 70 m, more or less, to the said northwest corner of lot 5643; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of lot 5643 to the westerly boundary of lot 5644; thence northerly along the said westerly boundary of lot 5644 to the northwest corner thereof; thence northwesterly 550 m, more or less, to a point on the southerly boundary of lot 905, said point being 200 m northeasterly along the said southerly boundary of lot 905 from the southwest corner thereof; thence southwesterly along the said southerly boundary of lot 905 to the southwesterly corner thereof, being a point on the southeasterly boundary of lot 210; thence southwesterly and northwesterly along the southeasterly and southwesterly boundary of lot 210 to the southerly boundary of lot 906; thence southwesterly 430 m, more or less, to the northeasterly corner of lot 721; thence southerly along the easterly boundary of lot 721 to the southeast corner thereof; thence southeasterly 950 m, more or less, to the northwest corner of lot 6649; thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said lot 6649 to the northeast corner thereof, being the point of commencement.
- B. In the Atlin Mining Division, commencing at the northwest corner of lot 314; thence due north 762 m; thence due west 1430 m, more or less, to a point due north of the most northerly northwest corner of lot 277; thence due south 700 m, more or less, to the said most northerly northwest corner of lot 277; thence southeasterly and southwesterly along the northerly and easterly boundaries of lot 277 to the most easterly southeast corner thereof; thence southeasterly 700 m, more or less, to a point on the westerly boundary of lot 257, said point being 300 m southerly along the said westerly boundary of lot 257 from the northwest corner thereof; thence northerly and easterly along the westerly and northerly boundary of lot 257 to the westerly boundary of lot 906; thence northerly and easterly along the westerly and northerly boundary of lot 906 to the westerly boundary of lot 378; thence northwesterly and northeasterly along the westerly and northerly boundary of lot 378 to the westerly boundary of lot 314; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of said lot 314 to the northwest corner thereof, being the point of commencement.

In the Atlin Mining Division, commencing at the northeast corner of lot 332; thence S 45° E 1 500 m; thence southwesterly 1 420 m, more or less, to the northwest corner of lot 971; thence westerly 700 m, more or less, to the northeast corner of lot 339; thence westerly along the north boundary of said lot 339 to the natural boundary of Fourth of July Creek on the left bank thereof; thence in a general northeasterly direction along the said left bank to the south boundary of lot 332; thence easterly and northerly along the southerly and easterly boundaries of said lot 332 to the northeast corner thereof, being the point of commencement.

D. In the Liard Mining Division, commencing at a point 2.4 km due east of survey post HW 421 of the Stewart-Watson Lake Highway, thence due south 3.6 km, more or less, to the easterly boundary of the Stewart-Watson Lake Highway Right of Way, thence in a general northwesterly direction along the said easterly boundary to a point due east of survey post HW 421 of the Stewart-Watson Lake Highway, thence due east to a point 2.4 km due east of said survey post HW 421, being the point of commencement.
