
On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Executive Council, orders that

1. The following described lands in the Revelstoke Mining Division, Kootenay Land District are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve until July 31, 1986:

Commencing at a point on the mean high water mark on the westerly shore of McNaughton Lake, said point being North 4° West 1 650 metres, more or less, from the Southwest corner of District Lot 800; thence North 29° West 1 925 metres; thence North 48° 30' East 3 325 metres; thence South 62° East 1 990 metres, more or less, to the point of intersection with the mean high water mark on the Westerly shore of McNaughton Lake; thence in a general southwesterly direction along the said Westerly shore of McNaughton Lake to a point North 4° West 1 650 metres, more or less, from the Southwest corner of District Lot 800, being the point of commencement.

2. No Free Miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
