EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA MAR 13.1985

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. The following described lands in the Victoria Mining Division, Highland and Lake Land Districts; are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Section 129, Lake Land District; thence due west 2 160 m, more or less, to the easterly boundary of Durrance Lake Regional Park; thence northerly, westerly, northerly and easterly along the said easterly and the southerly boundaries of Durrance Lake Regional Park to the northwest corner of Section 54, Highland Land District; thence easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly boundaries of the said Section 54, Highland Land District to the northwest corner of Section 127, Lake Land District; thence easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly boundaries of the said Section 127, Lake Land District, to the northeast corner of Section 128, Lake Land District; thence southerly along the easterly boundaries of the said Section 128, Lake Land District and Section 129, Lake Land District to the southeast corner of Section 129, Lake Land District, being the point of commencement.

2. No free miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
