On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. B.C. Reg. 196/85 is amended to the extent set out in section 2 for a period of 5 years from the effective date of this regulation.
2. A free miner may locate and record a mineral claim or acquire a location under the *Mineral Act* on all or part of the land in the Kamloops and Clinton Mining Divisions shown hatched in red on the attached plan and more particularly described in the schedule on the condition that immediately upon this section ceasing to have effect any mineral claim recorded on that land is forfeited to and vests in the Crown
