On the recommendation of the undersigned, the ~~Mineral Titles~~ ^{Administrator} by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. The following described lands in the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve:

SITE 1 936 61E

Commencing at a point 2375 metres N82°30'E of the Northeast corner of Lot 443; thence 475 metres N77°55'15"E; thence S12°04'45"E to the Northerly boundary of the right-of-way of the Barkerville highway thence 475 metres westerly along the said northerly boundary; thence Northwesterly in a straight line 500 metres, more or less, to a point 2375 metres N82°30'E from the Northeast corner of Lot 443, being the point of commencement.

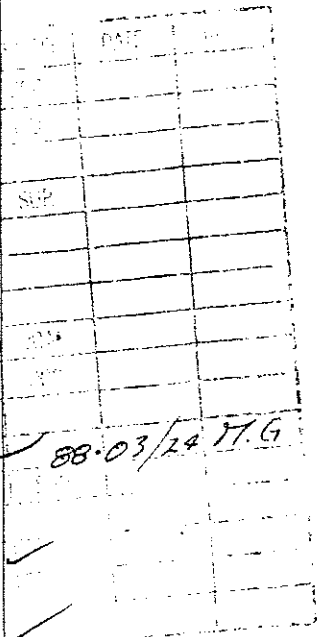

SITE 4 934 06W

Commencing at a point 650 metres S58°E of the point of intersection of the natural boundary of Towkukh Creek on the right bank thereof with the natural boundary of Bowron River on the left bank thereof; thence due East 500 metres; thence due South 500 metres, thence due West 500 metres; thence Northerly 500 metres, more or less, to a point 650 metres S58°E of the point of the right bank thereof with the natural boundary of Bowron River on the left bank thereof, being the point of commencement.

SITE 5 934


