EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA JUN. 15, 1988

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

1. B. C. Reg. 266/87 be repealed.
2. The following described lands in the Liard Mining Division, Cassiar Land District are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve:

All those parcels or tracts of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water known as Stikine River Recreation Area and as described in the attached schedule.
3. No free miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 2.

SCHEDULE

All Crown land within Cassiar Land District described as:

Commencing at the southeast corner of IR #8, Classy Creek; thence Southwesterly in a straight line to the southeast corner of Hlusta's Meadow, IR #2; thence West along the south boundary of Sald IR #2 to the southwest corner thereof; thence due West a distance of 3 km, more or less, to the right bank natural boundary of Lahltan River; thence Southwesterly in a straight line a distance of 9.5 km, more or less, to a point on the right bank natural boundary of 8 Mile Creek, said point lying 3 km perpendicularly north of the point of intersection of the right bank natural boundary of Stikine River and the right bank natural boundary of 8 Mile Creek; thence Southerly along said right bank natural boundary to the point of intersection with the southerly boundary of the Highway R/W, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104G 14/E; thence Southerly along said highway right-of-way lying due north of the point of intersection of the left bank natural boundary of Stikine River and the right bank natural boundary of Line Creek; thence due South to the left bank natural boundary of Stikine River; thence in a general Northeasterly direction along said left bank natural boundary to the point of intersection with the left bank natural boundary of Klastline River; thence in a general Southeasterly direction along Klastline River left bank natural boundary to a point thereon, said point lying 3 km south of the left bank natural boundary of Stikine River; thence East in a straight line a distance of 10 km, more or less, to the summit of Mount Meehaus; thence Northeasterly in a straight line a distance of 9 km, more or less, to elevation 3885 ±, lying south of Grand Canyon, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104J 1/W; thence Northeasterly in a straight line a distance of 5.8 km, more or less, to elevation 3535 ±, lying south of Grand Canyon, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104J 1/W; thence Southeasterly in a straight line, a distance of 25 km, more or less, to a point on the west boundary of Highway #37 (Shown as Highway #31 on NIS Topo Maps 104J 1/E and 104I 4/W), said point lying 3 km due south of the right bank natural boundary of Stikine River; thence Northeast in a straight line a distance of 4 km, more or less, to elevation 3444 ±, lying on Klastline Plateau, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104I 4/W; thence Southeast in a straight line a distance of 9 km, more or less, to the summit of Isaybahe Mountain; thence South in a straight line to Isaybahe Pass; thence in a general Easterly direction to the headwaters of Istogamus Creek; thence Southeasterly along the right bank natural boundary of said creek to the point of intersection with the left bank natural boundary of Klappan River; thence East in a straight line to a point, said point lying 1 km east of the center line of the B.C. Railway Right of Way and also due east of the point of intersection of the right bank natural boundary of Istogamus Creek and the left bank natural boundary of Klappen River; thence in a general Southerly direction along a line east of, parallel to and 1 km perpendicularly distant from said center line to the point of intersection with the right bank natural boundary of Isnadto Creek; thence in a general Easterly direction along said right bank natural boundary to the point of intersection with the 1066.80 metre contour; thence in a general Northwesterly, Northerly, and Easterly direction along the said 1066.80 m contour to the point of intersection with the right bank of McEwan Creek; thence Easterly along the said bank to a point due south of the summit of Isanaglode Mountain; thence due North to said summit; thence due East 15.5 km; thence due North 8 km, more or less, to a point on the right bank of Cullivan Creek; thence Northerly along the right bank of Cullivan Creek to a point lying three kilometres due south of the left bank of the Stikine River;

thence Easterly along a line parallel to and three kilometres perpendicularly distant from the left bank of said Stikine River to an unnamed creek which flows easterly in to Stikine River at a point 13.2 kilometres north and .8 km west, more or less, of the northeast corner of Lot 5974, Cassiar District.

thence Northeasterly along the left bank of said creek to the left bank natural boundary of the Stikine River;

thence Southeasterly along the said left bank natural boundary to the right bank natural boundary of Sanabar Creek;

thence S.55° E a distance of 16 km, more or less, to a point which lies east of and 1 kilometre perpendicularly distant, from the right bank natural boundary of Stikine River;

thence in a general Northerly direction along a line parallel to and 1 kilometre perpendicularly distant from the right bank natural boundary of Stikine River and then the left bank natural boundary of Chukachida River to a point there on, said point lying due north of the northwest corner of D.L. 5975;

thence due North 4 kilometres, more or less, to a point lying 3 kilometres perpendicularly distant from the right bank natural boundary of Chukachida River;

thence in a general Westerly direction along a line north of, parallel to and 3 kilometres perpendicularly distant from said natural boundary and the right bank natural boundary of Stikine River to a point thereon, said point lying due north of the point of intersection of the left bank natural boundary of Cullivan Creek and the right bank natural boundary of Stikine River;

thence Northwesterly in a straight line, a distance of 7.5 km, more or less, to the summit of Mt. Sister Mary, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104H; thence Northwesterly in a straight line, a distance of 25 km, more or less, to the summit of an unnamed mountain lying west of Beggerlay Creek and shown as elevation 6159 + on NIS Topo Map 104H/13;

thence Northwesterly in a straight line a distance of 10 km, more or less, to elevation 4155 + , lying east of Tees Creek, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104I 4/W;

thence Northwesterly in a straight line a distance of 6 km, more or less, to elevation 3250 + , lying east of Lees Creek, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104I 4/W;

thence Westerly in a straight line a distance of 9 km, more or less, to elevation 3425 + , lying west of Lees Creek, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104I 4/W;

thence Northwesterly in a straight line a distance of 6.1 km, more or less, to elevation 3218 + , lying south of Latham Creek, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104J 1/E;

thence Northwesterly in a straight line a distance of 8.5 km, more or less, to elevation 3655 + , lying west of Blaney Creek, as shown on NIS Topo Map 104J 1/E;

thence Northwesterly in a straight line a distance of 7 km, more or less, to a point on the left bank natural boundary of Pallen Creek, said point lying 3 km perpendicularly distant from the right bank natural boundary of Stikine River;

thence Northwesterly in a straight line to the Southeast corner of IR #8, Classy Creek being the point of commencement

save and except all Indian Reserves,

the whole containing 217,000 hectares, more or less.
