On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

MAR 11 1988

1. The following described lands in the Alberni Mining Division, Nootka Land District, are established as a mineral reserve until December 31, 1988:

RANALD CREEK:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the westerly boundary of the Esquimalt and Nanaimo Railway Land Grant with the southerly boundary of the Sayward Land District; thence southerly along the said westerly boundary to its point of intersection with the southerly boundary of the watershed of Nikie Creek; thence westerly along the height of land forming the said southerly boundary to the summit of Mount Flannigan; thence northerly along the height of land to the summit of Mount Evelyn; thence northerly along the height of land forming the watershed boundary of an unnamed creek draining Myra and Jessie Lakes into Salmon River to the point of intersection with the southerly boundary of Sayward Land District; thence easterly along the said southerly boundary of the Sayward Land District to its point of intersection with the westerly boundary of the Esquimalt and Nanaimo Railway Land Grant, being the point of commencement.




CREST CREEK:

Commencing at the summit of Puzzle Mountain; thence northerly along the westerly boundary of the watershed of Elk River to a horizontal control point at elevation of 5680 feet; thence northerly in a straight line to the most southerly southeast corner of Lot 181; thence northerly, easterly and northerly along the easterly, southerly and easterly boundaries of said Lot 181 to the point of intersection with the easterly boundary of the watershed of Crest Creek; thence in a general northerly direction along the easterly boundary of the watersheds of Crest Creek and Heber River to the summit of Mount Judson; thence due west 790 metres; thence southerly in a straight line to a point 1160 metres due west of the summit of Puzzle Mountain; thence due east to Puzzle Mountain, being the point of commencement.

2. No free miner shall record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
