

REGULATION OF THE MINISTER
IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT
S.B.C. 1988, C.5

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby establish the following reserves:

No Staking Reserve

1. (1) There is established a mineral and placer reserve over the following described lands in the New Westminster Mining Division, Group 1 New Westminster Land District:

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water as shown outlined on sketch 1.

(2) No free miner shall locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve created by subsection (1).

Conditional Reserve

2. (1) There is established a conditional mineral reserve over the following described lands in the New Westminster Mining Division, Group 1 New Westminster Land District:

An area 500 metres wide, being 250 metres on each side of the centre line of Norrish Creek extending downstream from the junction of Norrish Creek and Dickson Creek as shown on the attached sketch 2.

(2) A free miner may locate or record a mineral claim on all or part of the land in the mineral reserve subject to the conditions in subsection (3).

(3) Condition of release requires that free miners must notify Dewdney-Alouette Regional District 30 days prior to the commencement of exploration work.
